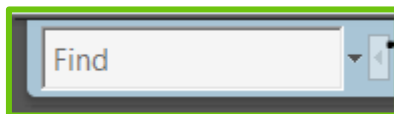
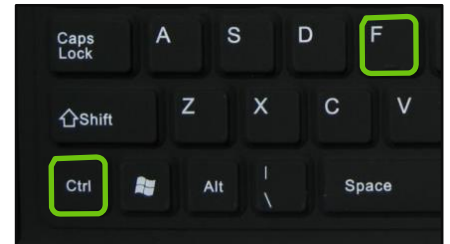


Use “Ctrl + F” to Find a Drug on the Formulary (list of covered drugs)

To quickly find a drug on our formulary, use the **Ctrl-F** function.
Here’s what you need to do:

- The **Ctrl button** on your computer keyboard is located on the bottom left-hand side.
- Press the “**Ctrl**” and “**F**” key at the same time.
- Once you do this, a blank box will pop up as shown here:



- Type in the name of your drug inside the box and hit the “**Enter**” key. You will be taken to the page this drug is listed on.
- If the drug is listed on more than one page, hit the “**Next**” button to go to the next page this drug is listed on.
